## HISTORY

#### 2016

The loss of the local masjid left the McLean Muslim community without a home. In 2016, the community faced the reality of being mosque-less and came together to solve this problem.

#### 2019

**McLean Islamic Society was established.** The masjid began with services such as Jummuah and a weekly Quran Halaqa. Growing and connecting with the community, a local high school MSA created a Service Learning Project to renovate the masjid with new paint and floor tiles. Volunteers wasted no time starting activities for children and youth, making community volunteerism a prominent trait of the masjid.

#### 2020 - 2022

**Resilience through the COVID-19 years.** Fueled with the hope to continue building a community, MIS held a small virtual presence during the first part of the COVID-19 years. As restrictions eased, the masjid created a Return To Masjid plan that adhered to health guidance and slowly provided in-person services.

#### 2022 - 2024

**Returning to a fully functioning masjid.** Moving quickly out of the pandemic, the community sought a place to call home. Many fundamental services and programming were developed and implemented to bring MIS to where it is today.


## **MIS TODAY**

The McLean Islamic Society has experienced remarkable growth over the past few years, evolving from a small intention to a thriving center of faith and community. From establishing two weekly Jummuah prayers to developing unique programs like the "IIm On Wheels" library (**a DMV-area first**), MIS has consistently sought to meet the diverse needs of its members. Weekly Tafseer Halaqas provide a space for deep Quranic study, and the popular monthly Family Night Program strengthens family bonds and community connections. The completion of Tafseer for 7 Juz, the expansion of the library to over 200 books, and the joyous occasions of revert Shahadas all stand as testaments to the breadth and depth of MIS's impact.

Community support, coupled with robust Ramadan programming, Eid celebrations, dedicated communication channels, and numerous community events, MIS continues to enrich the lives of Muslims in McLean and beyond.


